



## IHCA policy related to the use of spinnaker with the Hobie Cat 16

(Agreed by the IHCA Council at the Annual General Meeting November 1, 2005, Port Elizabeth, South Africa)

- 1. Appendix B to the IHCA Class Rules shall be maintained.
- 2. The Hobie Cat 16 in its original configuration without spinnaker and the Hobie Cat 16 in the configuration with spinnaker as defined by Appendix B to the IHCA Class Rules shall be considered a supplemental class to the Hobie Cat 16.
- 3. It shall be the strict policy of the regional, national, divisional associations and fleets under IHCA to maintain and ensure all H16 Open class events are sailed with the boat in its original configuration without spinnaker.
- 4. All disciplines at the IHCA Hobie 16 World Championships shall be sailed with the boat in its original configuration without spinnaker.
- 5. It shall be left up to the regional, national, divisional associations and fleets under IHCA to determine if they will organise events/activities using Appendix B to the IHCA Class Rules.

This policy replaces previous policies and decisions.
