The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat cannot protest against another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

1.1. The championship will be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the International Hobie Class Rules, the IHCA Discretionary and Standard Penalty Policy, and this Notice of Race except as any of these is altered by the Sailing Instructions

1.2. In all rules that apply to the event, “athlete” and “competitor” mean a person competing in the event. The term “support person” means a person as defined in the RRS.

1.3. [SP] means a rule for which a standard penalty may be imposed by the Race Committee or Technical Committee without a hearing or a discretionary punishment imposed by the Protest Committee with a hearing. This modifies RRS 63.1.



1.4. [DP] competitors and support personnel must comply with any request from an event racing officer. Failure to comply may be considered misconduct.

1.5. Reasonable actions by the event racing officers regarding recommendations, protocols or legislation relating to COVID-19, even if they later prove unnecessary, will not be considered improper actions or omissions.

1.6. Rule 44.1 of the 2021/2024 World Sailing RRS is changed to 01 (one) lap.

2. RACING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Championship General Sailing Instructions will be available from the event's administration the week of the start of the championship.

2.2. In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (RRS), the provisions of the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

3. COMMUNICATION

3.1. The official bulletin board of the Championship will be the WhatsApp group QA Brascat 22.

3.2. [DP] From the attention signal until the end of the race of the day, except in the case of an emergency, a boat shall not make voice and data transmissions and shall not receive voice and data transmissions that are not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATIONS

4.1. Are eligible all competitors who are in agreement with Appendix 19 of the World Sailing at the time of confirmation of entry;

4.2. that respect the ABCHC measurement regulations and are not under disciplinary punishment period and;

4.3. are even with the 2022 membership fees and an annuity of the Brazilian Hobie Cat Class Association – ABCHC.

4.4. Sailors must present proof of affiliation for the year 2022 to their respective State Federations.

4.5. For the HC16 Class Junior Brazilian Championship, both crew members must be under 19 years of age by December 31, 2022.

4.6. For the HC16 Class Women's Brazilian Championship, both crew members must be female.

4.7. Registrations can be made via the ICAJU website until 11/01/2022 via the following links:

4.8. After 11/01/2022, registrations will only be received at the event's administration, located at the event's official headquarters.

4.9. All participants must confirm their registration by registering at the event's administration by 6:00pm on the 12th of November 2022. Upon registration, the participant will receive his participation kit and the Sailing instructions.

5.2. REIMBURSEMENT

3. Refund request submitted between 10/01/2022 and 10/20/2022 – 20% of the fee will be reimbursed.

6. ADVERTISING

- 6.1. In this event, World Sailing Regulation 20 applies.
- 6.2. Participating boats may be required to display advertising chosen and provided by the championship organization.

7. REPLACEMENT OF EQUIPMENT AND CREW

- 7.1. Substitution of crew and equipment is allowed.
- 7.2. The replacement of crew and equipment must be requested in a specific form available at the Event administration office and must be approved by the Race Committee.

8. PROGRAM

- 8.1. It will consist of a single series of regattas.
- 8.2. For Hobie Cat Classes 14 and 16, eleven races are scheduled, with up to 04 (four) races per day.
- 8.3. For the Hobie Cat 16 with Spinnaker Class (Youth Sailing - up to 18 years old) and Female: 06 (six) races are scheduled, with up to 04 (four) races per day.
- 8.4. The daily schedule will be as follows:

8.5. Changes to the Schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board until 7:00 pm the day before the start of each Stage.

9. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1. It is the vessel's helmsman's obligation to keep his boat and crew in compliance with the measurement and weighing rules. He/she cannot claim disqualification for failure to comply with such regulations. All boats and equipment will be inspected by the OFFICIAL CLASS GAUGE.

9.2. Any boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules, this Notice or the Sailing Instructions. On the water, a boat may be instructed by the CR to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

10. VENUE

10.1. The championship will have as its official headquarters the IATE CLUBE DE ARACAJU - ICAJU, located at Av. Beira Mar, SN, Praia Treze de Julho – Aracaju/SE, and will have all the necessary infrastructure for the good performance of the competition.

10.2. The race area will be mounted in the Sea, after the “boca da Barra do Rio Sergipe”, coastal region of Praia de Atalaia.

11. ROUTES

11.1. Courses will be official Hobie Cat Class and will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1. RRS 44.1 is amended so that the two-round penalty is replaced by the one-round penalty.

12.2. Appendix T of 2021/2024 World Sailing RRSs will apply.

13. SCORE

13.1. For the General Hobie Cat Class, 11 (eleven) races are scheduled, and the championship will be valid with the conclusion of at least 04 (four) races.

13.1.1. For the Hobie Cat General Class discards will occur as follow: up to 04 races, the boat's score will be the sum of its scores. From 05 to 11 races, the boat's score will be the sum of its scores, excluding its worst result.

13.2. For the Hobie Cat 16 spinnaker Classes (Youth Sailing - Up to 18 years old) and the Female classes, the score will be as follow: 06 (six) races are scheduled, and the championship will be valid with the completion of at least 02 (two) races.

13.2.1. The boat's score in these classes will be up to 04 (four) races the sum of her scores, from 05 (five) to 06 (six) races, the boat's score will be the sum of her scores, excluding her worst result.

14. LOCATION

14.1. [DP] Boats must remain at the event location during the entire period of the championship.

14.2. The championship headquarters will be able to receive participants from 10/10/2022, and participants must inform the Championship Secretary in advance.

15. DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY

15.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue the race rests solely with her.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These hazards include high winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, equipment failure, boat handling errors, poor navigation by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue, resulting in an increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing and the risk of permanent and catastrophic injury or death from drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

15.2. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. Consider rule 3, Decision to Compete. ABCHC, late Clube de Aracaju and any other organizers of the event, the Race Committee, the Protest Committee and all parties involved in the organization of the event, do not assume any responsibility for accidents, including death, damage, personal loss, materials or of any other nature, referring to boats and participants, before, during and after the event. Participants are competing at their own risk and responsibility.

16. AWARDS

16.1. The prize will be distributed as follows.

16.2. HOBIE CAT 16 WITH SPINNAKER (YOUTH CLASS - UP TO 18 YEARS)

1st to 3rd place

16.3. HOBIE CAT 16 FEMALE

1st to 3rd place

16.4. OPENING RACE

Hobie Cat 14 – 1st to 3rd Place / Hobie Cat 16 – 1st to 3rd Place

16.5. MAIN EVENT

Hobie Cat 14 – 1st to 5th Place Overall / 1st “Dinocat Category” / 1st Master / 1st Gran Master / 1st Super Gran Master / 1st Rookie

16.6. Hobie Cat 16 – 1st to 10th Place General / 1st National Boat / 1st “Dinocat Category” / 1st and 2nd Master 1st and 2nd Gran Master / 1st and 2nd Double Gran Master / 1st Double Super Gran Master / 1st Place Rookie

16.7. If the helmsman is not Brazilian, he will participate in the event as GUEST, not living up to the title of BRAZILIAN CHAMPION, but he will receive the award normally. The title of Brazilian champion is restricted to a crew composed of a Brazilian helmsman.

17. SUPPORT BOATS

17.1. Support boats – Federations, Clubs, Coaches and Support – must be registered at the event administration, and those responsible for the vessel will be duly identified and will receive instructions on how to behave and position themselves in the race area.

18. SECURITY

18.1. It is mandatory to wear a life jacket at all times when the participant is in the water. According to the class rules, each vessel must, mandatorily, carry a turning cable on the boat.

18.2. The participant will be required to present to the event administration, at the time of registration confirmation, his/her life jacket (vest) approved by the certifying authority and which is suitable for use by the athlete. The use of the Lifeguard will be required and supervised in the course of disputes. The athlete who is caught without being properly dressed with the lifeguard approved by the organization will be summarily disqualified from the races of the day.

19. FURTHER INFORMATION

19.1. Boat rental: The championship organization is committed to assisting participants who wish to rent boats to participate in the championship, indicating possible suppliers. Interested parties should contact ABCHC: email: contato@abchc.com.br or Phone: +55 79 99982-0200.

19.2. Accommodation: The list with options for Hotel, Inn and Others will soon be available. The event will try to provide a residence for accommodation, at an attractive cost, and those interested must make a prior request, after confirming their registration for the event. Spaces will be limited, and those interested must bring bed and bath linen and will be responsible for the maintenance of the place, including cleaning.

19.4. Prevention protocols against COVID-19:

19.4.1. To access the facilities of the Yacht Clube de Aracaju, it will be required to present the specific RT-PCR exam with a negative result for COVID-19, carried out within a maximum of 48 hours of the first access to the ICAJU, being released whoever presents a vaccination card proving to have received the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

19.4.2. The use of protective masks is mandatory on all ICAJU premises.

19.4.3. The violation of item 18.4 is serious and will be subject to the application of rule 69 – Misconduct.
